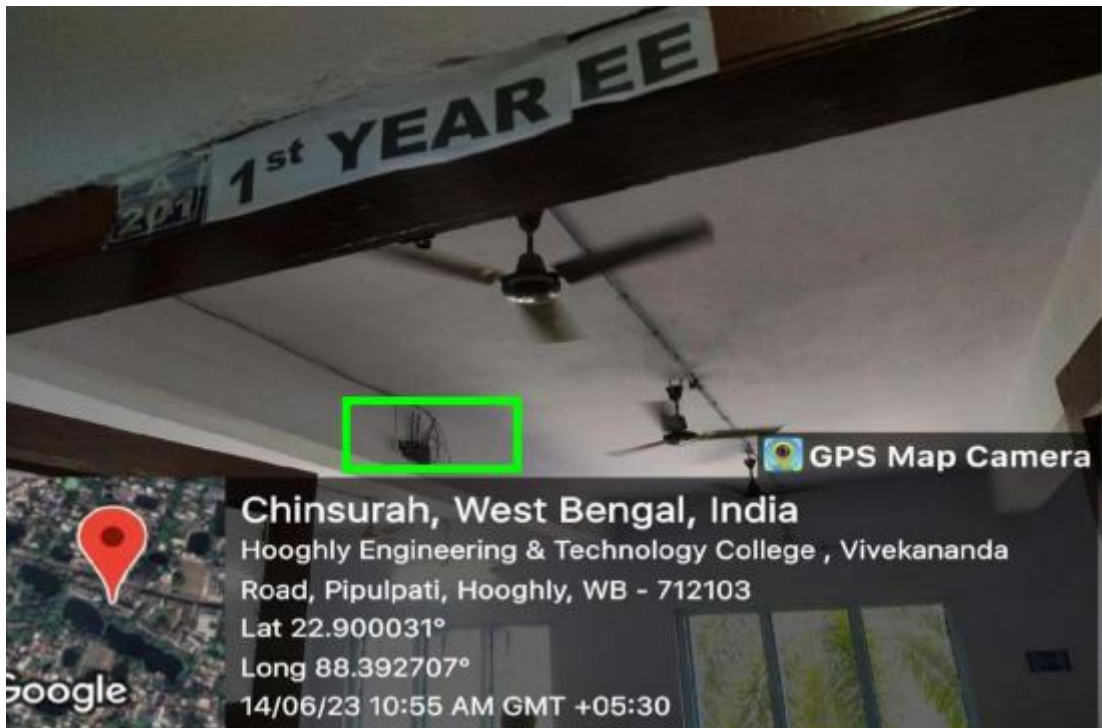

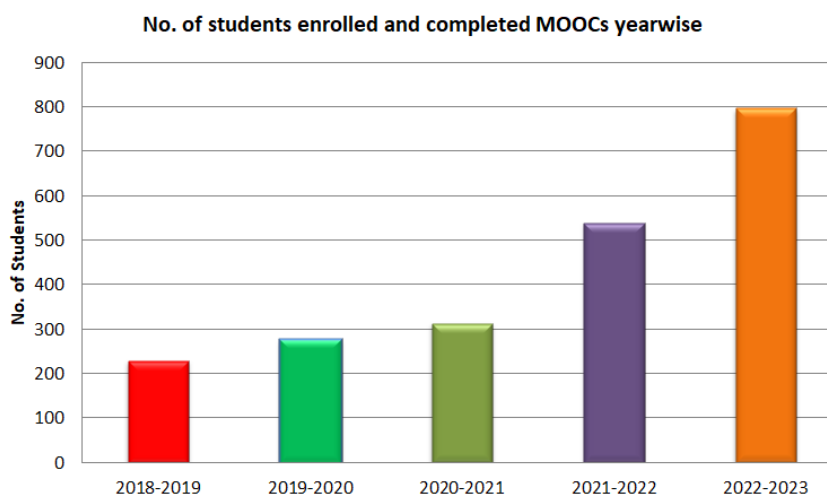

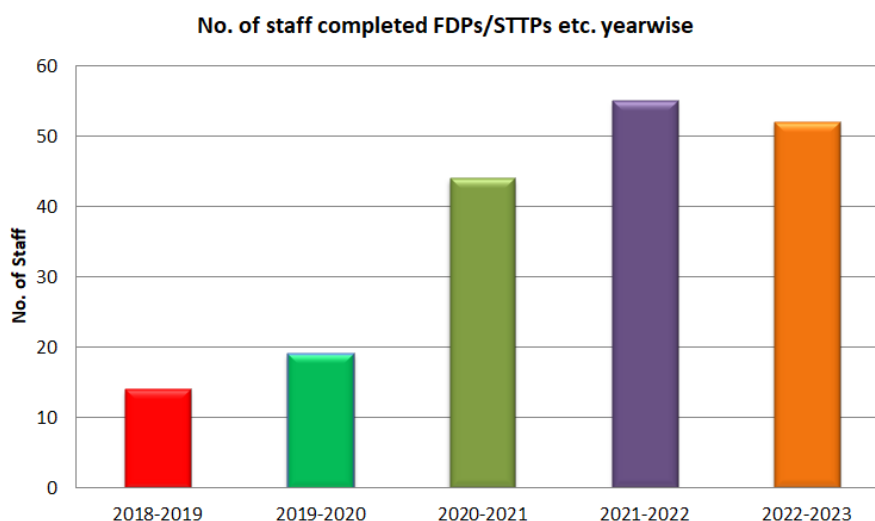

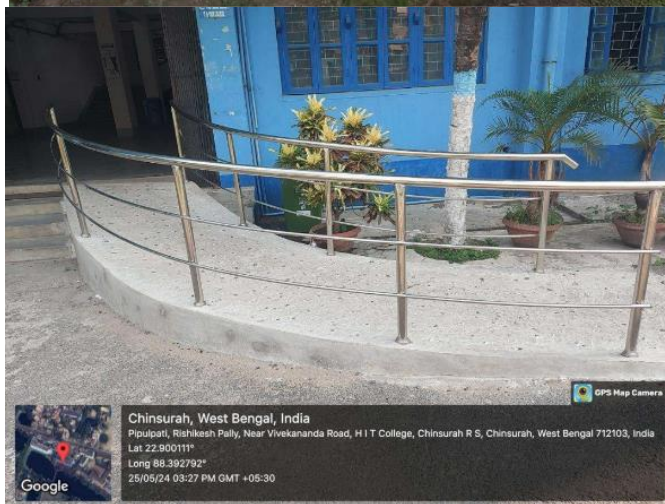

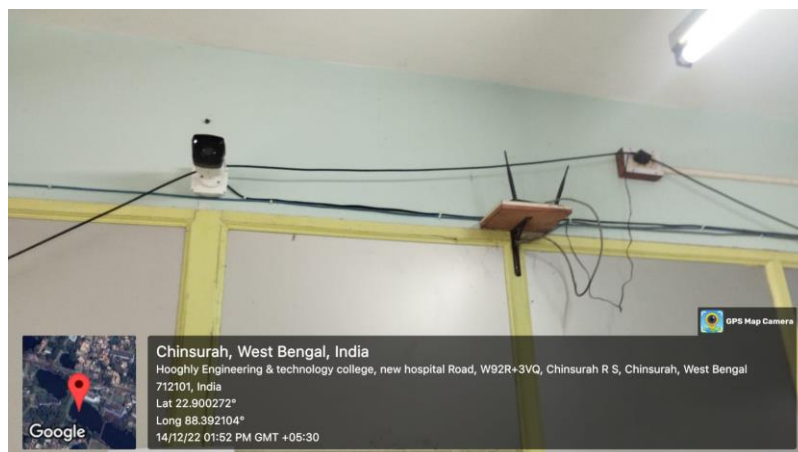
SOLAR PANEL ON THE ROOF OF THE FACULTY BLOCK
