### 1.0 PREFACE

The aim of this gender audit was to ensure that the college campus becomes a safer and more supportive space for all individuals, irrespective of their gender. By fostering gender equality, we strive to create a society where every person can thrive and contribute their unique skills and perspectives without being limited by societal expectations or discriminated against based on their gender identity.

## 2.0 INTRODUCTION

Gender Equality is a global issue, and discussions on women's emancipation and her rights are at the forefront of many worldwide formal and informal campaigns. As the awareness of gender issues increases, women spontaneously take action against women's oppression and exploitation. Gender awareness allows women to move beyond other conventional gender stereotypes and rigid gender role definitions. The gender audit was conducted to identify ways to make college campus safer for women. The audit process involved choosing the sites to be audited, selecting the participants, orientation to the participants, preparing the checklist and the walk—about, writing down the findings and sharing the results with the principal of the college for implementation of the recommendations.

### 3.0 A BRIEF OVERVIEW ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Hooghly Engineering & Technology College (HETC) is a self-financed institution established under the aegis of the Hooghly Engineering & Technology College Society (HETCS). ### 8.0 CONCEPT OF GENDER AUDIT

A gender audit in the context of colleges involves a systematic review and assessment of the institution's policies, practices, and procedures to ensure gender equality and identify areas where gender bias or discrimination might be present. Here's a detailed explanation of the concept and process of a gender audit:

- Purpose: The primary goal of a gender audit is to evaluate how effectively an institution promotes gender equality and ensures a safe and supportive environment for all students, regardless of gender.
- Scope: It encompasses examining various aspects of college life including admissions, curriculum, teaching methodologies, extracurricular activities, student support services, campus facilities, and administrative practices.
- Evaluation Criteria: The audit assesses whether the college adheres to government regulations and policies related to gender equality. It also evaluates the impact of current policies and proposes strategies for improvement.
- Identifying Gender Bias: Through the audit process, specific areas where gender bias or discrimination may exist are identified. This could include disparities in opportunities, unequal treatment, stereotyping, harassment issues, or inadequate support systems for female students.
- Strategies for Improvement: Based on the findings, recommendations are made to address identified issues and promote a more inclusive environment. These strategies may include policy revisions, awareness campaigns, training programs for staff and students, and enhancing support mechanisms for gender minorities.

### 9.0 PROCESS OF GENDER AUDIT:

- Preparation: Define the scope and objectives of the gender audit. Establish a gender audit committee or task force comprising representatives from various stakeholders including faculty, administrative staff, students (both male and female), and external experts if needed.
- Data Collection: Gather relevant data and information through surveys, interviews, focus group discussions, and review of existing policies and documentation. This helps in understanding the current situation regarding gender equality within the college.
- Analysis: Analyse the collected data to identify patterns, trends, and areas of concern related to gender equality. This includes examining statistical data, qualitative feedback, and comparing practices with established standards and best practices.
- Report Preparation: Compile the findings into a comprehensive report that highlights strengths, weaknesses, challenges, and opportunities for improvement. The report should include concrete recommendations with clear action plans and timelines.
- Implementation: Present the findings and recommendations to college leadership and stakeholders. Develop an action plan to implement recommended changes, allocate resources, assign responsibilities, and monitor progress.
- Monitoring and Evaluation: Continuously monitor the implementation of action plans and evaluate their effectiveness. Regularly review policies and practices to ensure ongoing compliance with gender equality principles and address emerging issues.



### 10.0 KEY STEPS IN GENDER AUDIT

- Planning Setting the objectives and scope of the audit, determining the methodology, and creating a detailed plan for conducting the audit.
- Data Collection Conducting surveys, interviews, focus group discussions, reviewing relevant documents and policies, and observing practices within the organization.
- Report Preparation Final report including the audit observations, identified issues, and recommendations for improvement, incorporating feedback and additional information. The report presents comprehensive the findings, conclusions, and recommendations.

### 11.0 GENDER SENSITIVE FEATURES OF HETC

Gender sensitive features are carefully observed in every corner of the University system. By forming various committees like Anti-ragging, Internal Complaints, and Sexual Harassment Prevention, and providing adequate facilities to both girls and boys, gender equality is kept upright in the University.

### 12.0 BENEFITS OF GENDER AUDIT:

- Promotes Gender Equality: Ensures that colleges create an environment where all students feel valued and have equal opportunities to succeed academically and socially.
- Enhances Institutional Reputation: Demonstrates a commitment to diversity, inclusion, and social responsibility, which can attract prospective students, faculty, and donors.
- Improves Student Experience: Reduces instances of gender-based discrimination or harassment, leading to a safer and more supportive learning environment.
- Compliance with Regulations: Helps colleges align with government regulations and policies on gender equality, avoiding legal or reputational risks.

### 13.0 FACILITIES FOR STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES

HETC is always flourished with students. To avoid rush and other mishaps, separate provisions are made at various places for girls.

- Security in the Entrance: The security at entrance helps avoiding chaotic situation. It is one of the safety measurements for students and to maintain discipline.
- Parking Facilities: A well observed parking of two-wheelers as well as four wheelers for girls, boys and staff is one of the disciplines in this University.
- Study Room: A study room that caters well to the needs of all students as well as the staff.
- Separate Circulation Counters and Reading Rooms: Girls and boys have separate circulation counters as well as reading rooms in the library. It marks a discipline.
- Ladies Common Room: Provision is made for girls to rest in Ladies Room. There is an adequate place and silence kept for girls to study. A notice board is also placed in Ladies Room.
- Washroom Facility: At four different places girls and boys washrooms are situated in the University with ample supply of water and regular cleaning. It is supplemented with a separate facility for the staff.
- Drinking Water: Three water coolers and water purifiers are placed for students and staff at convenient places.



- Ramp: Keeping in mind the needs of physically challenged students, ramps have been provided in both buildings to ease accessibility.
- Suggestion Box: Suggestion boxes have been provided to inculcate student feedback in University management.
- Waste Management: Keeping in mind the need to manage waste efficiently, vermin composting units that facilitate solid waste management have been provided. Also, student awareness about the same is looked after.
- CCTV: CCTV cameras have been installed on every floor to look after the security aspect as well as management of the University. These have been installed in corridors, library, reading rooms, ground and office and exam department.
- Notice Boards: Notice boards are available on every floor as well as for every department. This is supplemented with electronic notice board at the main entrance that displays important notices applicable to all students.
- What's App Notice Alert System: An SMS Alert System for information dissemination about important dates and notices among the students and the staff is managed.
- Unique ID Number: Unique ID Number is provided to all the students as well as all the employees of the institute.
- Library: The library has a wide range of text books/ reference books/ e-literature in each subject along with a research information centre. It is an updated library and every year the books are updated according to the syllabus provided by the staff. There are also national and international journal, books for competitive exam and free internet facility for students. Reading festivals and book exhibitions are arranged under the initiative of the library. In the year 2018-19 book exhibition was organized by the library.
- Sports facilities: The University takes special efforts to promote sports among the students. Indoor games in the college are chess, table tennis and Carrom. Outdoor games are Kabbadi, athletics, cricket, badminton and football.
- Yoga: Yoga training is given to students and teachers every year.
- Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine: Keeping in mind the special hygiene needs of girl students and female staff, multiple sanitary napkin vending machines are provided in ladies hostels.




Fig. 1: Structure of Gender Equality




Fig: 2. Gender - wise composition of the members in Governing Body




Fig: 3.Gender - wise composition of all Employees in HETC: 2022-23




Fig: 4. Gender - wise composition of the Teaching Staff




Fig: 5. Designation - wise Gender Details of Professor / Associate Professor / Assistant Professor




Fig: 6. Gender wise composition of the Technical Assistant




Fig: 7. Gender wise composition of the Library Staff




Fig: 8. Gender - wise composition of the Administrative staff




Fig: 10. Gender wise composition of the Hostel Staff




Fig: 11. Summary of Gender wise composition for all the Convener of different Committees/Cells/Units




Fig: 12. Gender - wise composition of the members in Internal Quality Assurance Cell




Fig: 14. Gender - wise composition of the members in Internal Complaint Committee




Fig: 15. Gender - wise composition of the members in Disciplinary Committee




Fig: 16. Gender - wise composition of the members in Women's Cell




Fig: 17. Gender - wise composition of the members in Anti - Ragging Committee




Fig. 19: Gender - wise composition of the members in SC / ST Committee




Fig: 20. Gender - wise composition of the Student Details




Fig: 21. Gender - wise composition of the Students in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE)




Fig: 22. Gender - wise composition of the Students in Electronics and Communications Engineering (ECE) Department




Fig: 23. Gender wise composition of the Students in Electrical Engineering (EE) Department




Fig: 24. Gender - wise composition of the Students in Civil Engineering (CE) Department




Fig: 25. Gender - wise composition of the Students in Mechanical Engineering (ME) Department




Fig: 26. Gender - wise composition of the Placed Students for the Academic Session 2022-2023

- Regular Monitoring and Evaluation: Establish a framework for regular monitoring and evaluation of gender equality initiatives to track progress, identify areas for improvement, and ensure accountability.
- Faculty and Staff Training: Provide ongoing training for faculty (FDP) and staff (SDP) on gender sensitivity, inclusive teaching practices, and creating a supportive environment for all students.
- Student Feedback Mechanism: Implement a structured feedback mechanism to regularly solicit input from students on their experiences related to gender inclusivity and identify areas needing improvement.

Implementing these suggestions will help the college further strengthen its commitment to gender equality, inclusivity, and creating a supportive environment where all students can thrive.


## Celebration of National Girl Child Day 2022




