






## 4 Days Workshop On UHV



After the valuable speech of Mr. Tapas Mukhopadhyay, the anchor, Mr. Subham Ganguly


opened the session for discussion. Mr. Mukhopadhyay answered the questions from the students

to clear their ambiguity.


